

How to download an app

These instructions will tell you how to download an app on your device.

You can download apps from Google Play.

Google Play is sometimes also called the Play Store.

Google Play is like an online shop where you can purchase different apps for your phone, computer or tablet.

The Google Play icon looks like this:



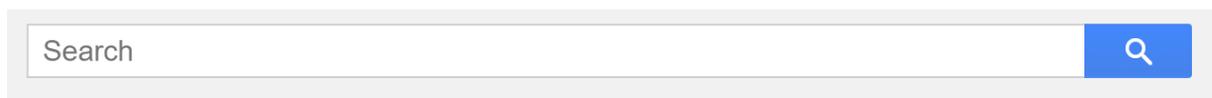
Google Play is also an app.

Instructions

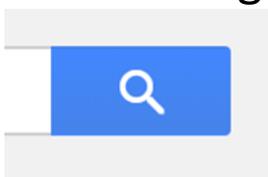
1. Turn on and unlock your device.
2. Tap on the Google Play app icon or open the Google Play web page on the internet.



3. You will see the 'search' bar at the top of the page.



4. You can type in the name of the app in the search bar. Let's download Zoom as an example.
5. Type in 'zoom' into the search bar.
6. Press the magnifying glass icon.



7. Tap on the Zoom icon. Usually the first app on the left-hand side will be the app you are looking for.



8. Click on the Install icon.



9. The app will install automatically onto your device and appear on your homescreen.

10. To use the Zoom app, tap on it and it will open.

Things to know!

Apps and Storage Space

Every app you download uses up a certain amount of internal storage space on your device. When storage space is low, your phone or tablet can start having issues.

To check storage space, open your phone's Settings by clicking on the Settings icon.



Then tap Storage.



To 'uninstall' an app, you can 'tap and hold' the apps icon and press Uninstall. It looks like a bin.
